

25 Question Game Instructions

This is a fun and interactive game for high school students to learn more about each other while answering questions touching upon media literacy and civil discourse.

How to Play

Print out the question cards – cut and shuffle them – lay the deck of cards face down on your table.

Depending upon the size of the group, every person can answer selected questions, or each person takes a turn picking up a card and answering the question. The only rules are 1) everyone agrees to participate; 2) the responses are respected; and 3) people commit to having fun and being creative! Feel free to add questions to the game – there are blank question cards.
